

SUMMARY OF *HOT NEWS* FOR JUNE 2009

Maciek and Mary Stolarski - Literature, U.K.:

Maciek and Mary provide tools for pastors in other parts of the world helping them in their work to be faithful to God's Word. Some material used is the Radio booklets produced from programmes. New requests for materials receive the four booklets on Luke's Gospel.

A person from Ethiopia recently wrote back saying how these materials were very helpful to him. He asked for more booklets which would be important for his ministry. Mary sent *Preachers' Study Papers* (PSP) on Preaching.

Maciek is involved in preparing the PSP. A contact from Argentina wrote saying that he had been using the PSP on Galatians along with Luther's work on Galatians and had translated it into Spanish for teaching preachers. A contact in Colombo, Sri Lanka wrote saying that the PSP on Galatians was being used to teach a group of Bible students.

The last PSP prepared was on Numbers - the first entirely on an O.T. book. African pastors have written saying that it was unusual for them to preach through this book and so they were thrilled with the PSP and now want volume two!

Currently, Hebrews (1) is being prepared and should be ready later this year.

Please pray for the ongoing production and distribution of suitable literature and that the books will have a great spiritual impact on the lives of those who read them.

Pat needed to come to the U.K. to visit her sister, Violet, who has learning difficulties and has been in hospital since December. The impact of the world crisis will affect available financing and also the construction industry in Spain has collapsed. The buyer of the present site wants to build housing on the site so there would need to be a change in the permit for the use of the site.
